

## Implementation Strategy Action Plan

Fulton County Medical Center (FCMC), in collaboration with Fulton County Family Partnership (FCFP) and Tri-State Community Health Center (Tri-State), is committed to achieving the “triple aim:” improved health through better quality of care at lower costs. To that end, to address the needs of the community, FCMC and the collaborative agencies are committed to the following strategies listed below. The FCMC Administration has committed to a budget of \$300,000 over the next three years (\$100,000 per year) to ensure the achievement of the Implementation Strategy goals outlined here in order to provide the necessary education and services to the community.

### Goal 1: Improve chronic disease prevention, access to care and care management in collaboration with Tri-State and other community providers

1. Establish an on-site diabetes education and care management program at Tri-State's McConnellsburg office
2. Continue to expand and improve the FCMC diabetes education program
3. Continue to grow the FCMC wound care program
4. Continue to monitor A1C testing results at health fairs
5. Determine collaborative approach for joint cardiac programming
6. Determine collaborative approach for joint obesity programming

### Goal 2: Improve Access and Care Coordination for the Underserved in Fulton County

1. Continue to expand insurance coverage by offering access to health care marketplace services
2. Implement a school based health clinic if determined feasible
3. Determine long term primary care recruitment and management strategy
4. Determine long term specialty care recruitment strategy
5. Explore population health model(s ) integrating physical/behavioral health
6. Formalize the rural health network to ensure access to high quality health care services across the continuum

### Goal 3: Develop a full continuum of aging services to meet the needs of older persons in Fulton County

1. Continue to explore options for developing senior living services/ assisted living on FCMC's campus
2. Continue to integrate hospice into the continuum of aging services
3. Developing an Advanced Illness/End of Life Care Management Program including the addition of an advance directive (POLST) in the electronic health record of patients, long term care residents, and home health patients.
4. Collaborate with Franklin/Fulton Area Agency on Aging and Franklin/Fulton Mental Health
5. Create a collaboration with housing authorities, senior trade organizations
6. Continue to grow the Alzheimer's Dementia support group
7. Establish a workgroup to review the collected data and investigate programs to offer to the Senior population

### Goal 4: Improve the quality of life for the families of Fulton County

1. Establish a workgroup to review the collected data and investigate programs to offer to the impoverished community
2. To increase protective factors that reduce problem behavior
3. Increase access to Drug and Alcohol treatment providers in Fulton County
4. Bring awareness to illegal and prescription drug problems within Fulton County
