McCONNELLSBURG - The Fulton County Medical Center Foundation donated a complete Automated External Defibrillator (AED) kit to Cove Valley Camp this week.

An AED is a portable device that is used to treat a person whose heart has suddenly stopped working.

“We will be placing it in the Retreat Center where we have the dining hall and indoor activities area,” said Allen Eshleman, Camp Director. “We are appreciative of Fulton County Medical Center Foundation for their generosity. Usually when you get something new, you can’t wait to try it, but in this case, I hope we never have to use it. Yet, it’s comforting to know we have it in case we do.”

“A few years ago, we donated an AED to the McConnellsburg Lions Club Park and it was used to save a life that summer during Little League season,” said Mike Straley, Executive Director of the FCMC Foundation. “With the number of visitors and guests that Cove Valley sees throughout the year, it’s reassuring to know they have an AED to save a life.”
