Hyperbaric Therapy (HBOT) at FCMC

Our wound center at FCMC offers a variety of specialized services to meet our patients wound care needs. We have a number of specialized physicians and staff who are skillfully trained in the art of healing chronic wounds as well as, many other conditions. We work closely with Home Health and can provide nutritional interventions to treat the whole individual. We also can offer care associated with chronic Lymphedema when a wound is present.

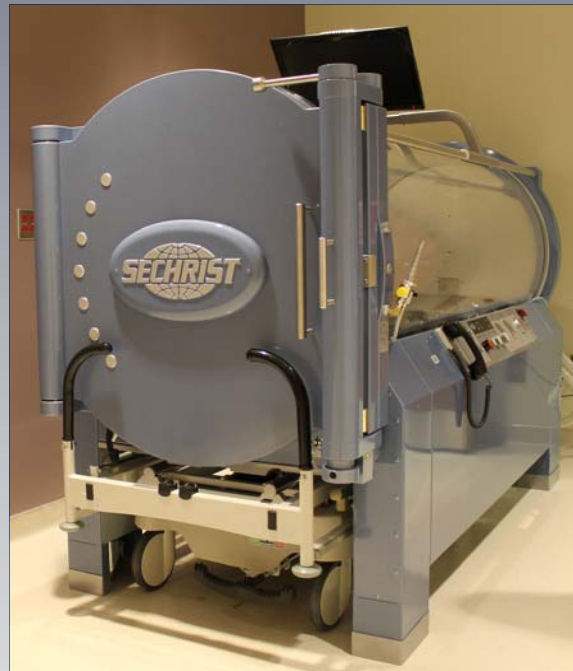
What is HBOT?

For more advanced wounds, Hyperbaric Oxygen Therapy (HBOT) may be an option for a patient's plan of care. HBOT is a medical treatment approved by the Undersea & Hyperbaric Medicine Society where the patient breathes 100% oxygen intermittently while enclosed in a hyperbaric oxygen chamber. A patient can relax while being closely monitored by our HBOT technicians and is encouraged to watch a movie or listen to relaxing music during their treatment.



HBOT has been proven effective for many medical conditions including those listed below:

- Diabetic foot wounds (that are slow to heal or simply not healing)
- Compromised Skin Grafts and Flaps
- Soft tissue radionecrosis (destruction due to radiation)
- Chronic refractory osteomyelitis (bone disease)
- Progressive necrotizing infections
- Osteoradionecrosis (oral cancer)



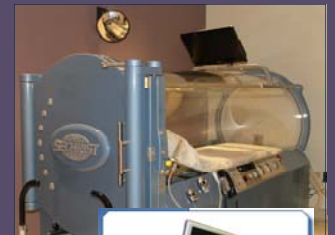
How does it work?

RELAX. After receiving a comprehensive wound assessment from one of our highly trained staff, we will assist you in implementing any needs and concerns you may have. Our staff, will work with you in developing our plan of care including physical and emotional treatment as well as insurance assistance. **Making your health our highest priority.**

What is it?

The 3600H hyperbaric chamber is the **FIRST IN PATIENT COMFORT.** The chamber includes an entertainment system complete with a TV/DVD player and music for your listening pleasure. The specialized hyperbaric chamber stretcher allows for direct patient transport into the chamber. We also have supportive position devices in the chamber to help you relax while lying down.
